

Introduction

AT GUIDEPOSTS, we believe the power of prayer can transform lives, connect people and communities, and ultimately, help transform the world into a better place. With the current global health and economic crises, we know that the world needs prayer now more than ever.

But for 75 years, Guideposts has known that prayer is important not just in times of crisis, but to face everyday challenges as well. In fact, the right prayer can help you through any life situation or experience—big or small.

In 1945 Norman Vincent Peale and his wife Ruth Stafford Peale founded *Guideposts* magazine, which continues to bring true stories of hope and inspiration to millions around the world. Today, the Outreach Division of Guideposts receives more than 5,000 prayer requests a month; young and old, rich and poor—they all continue to reach out, whether through written requests, online or on our social media outlets.

Many of the prayers in this booklet were used by Dr. Peale in sermons he delivered at the historic Marble Collegiate Church in New York City decades ago. Some were written more recently. But together the collection addresses a broad range of situations and human experiences. Looking for love? There's a prayer for that. Moving? Facing retirement? Needing strength or feeling hopeless? There are specific prayers to help you cope.

“Pray without ceasing,” the Apostle Paul said. We hope these prayers will serve as a guide to help you strengthen your daily prayer practice, deepen your faith, and tap into the amazing power of prayer.

Daily Prayers

At the Start of the Day

**The LORD has done it this very day;
let us rejoice today and be glad.**

PSALM 118:24

Dear Lord, thank You for this new day; I accept it as a precious gift from You. I will try my best to use it to do Your will—minute by minute, hour by hour. Guide me throughout the day in order that I may make the best decisions and treat everyone I encounter with kindness. Amen.

At the End of the Day

**I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone,
O LORD, make me dwell in safety.**

PSALM 4:8

Heavenly Father, I close this day with thoughts of You. Thank You for watching over me from sunrise to sunset. Forgive the sins I committed today and infuse me with insight and understanding so that I will not commit them again tomorrow. Grant me a good night's rest and surround me with Your love and peace so that I may follow Your path again tomorrow. In Jesus' name. Amen.

For Guidance

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.

PROVERBS 3:5

God, the world can be a complicated place these days; in order to make my way, I need Your guidance multiple times throughout the day. Deepen my understanding. Help me hear Your voice and heed Your advice. Keep me walking faithfully right along beside You. Amen.

For Energy

They will soar on wings as eagles;

Lord, I need more energy to get through my day. Refresh my spirit and change my thoughts to be in harmony with Your heavenly power. Keep me close to You—the divine source of energy that never depletes. Amen.
